City Clerk Angela Wirth reported that the proposed FY 2025-2026 Budget is slightly higher than previously presented. This increase is due to the availability of updated and nearly final revenue figures. Ms. Wirth also confirmed that all legal requirements on the City's part have been completed, and the budget is now ready, balanced, and prepared for a vote. Mayor Pro-Tem Bruce Davis asked for a motion to approve the FY 2025-2026 proposed budget as presented. Councilman Andrew Altman made the motion to approve FY 2025-2026 proposed budget as presented.
